Recipe of the Month - Ranch Buffalo Chicken Wing Dip

Preparation time—5 minutes Cook time—25 minutes Servings –12

This is literally the perfect party dip! Creamy, cheesy and spicy; this Buffalo wing flavored dip is loaded with shredded chicken and tons of yummy cheese.

Ingredients:

- 8 oz. softened cream cheese
- 1/2 cup ranch dressing
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 2 cups shredded chicken
- I cup buffalo sauce divided
- 2 green onions, thinly sliced
- I cup shredded Monterey jack cheese

Corn tortillas for serving

Instructions:

Preheat Oven to 375 Degrees

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Combine cream cheese, sour cream, ranch dressing and green onions with a mixer on medium speed. Spread into the bottom of a pie plate or small casserole dish.

Toss chicken with 1/2 cup buffalo sauce. Spread over cream cheese mixture and drizzle with remaining buffalo sauce.

Top with cheeses and bake 25-30 minutes or until hot and bubbly.
