

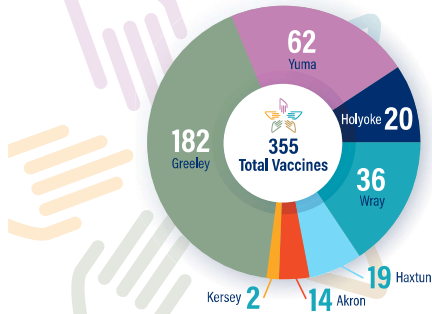

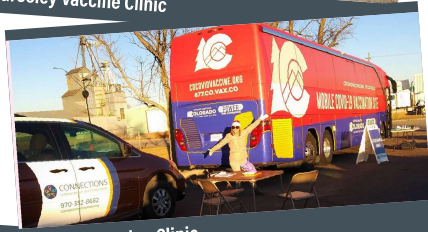
Challenge Barriers. Build Independence.

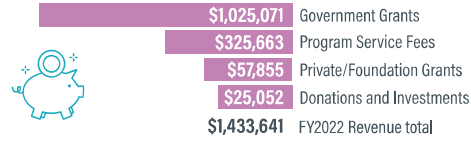
Colorado Disability Fund Committee (CDFC)

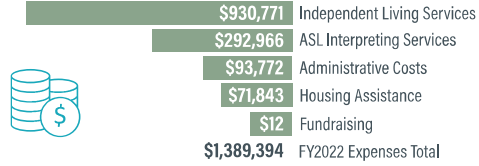
